

COVID 19 POLICY AUGUST 2021

As confirmed in the [First Minister's announcement](#) (5 August), Wales will move to alert level zero at **6am on 7 August**.

At alert level zero, many of the legal requirements in tourism & hospitality settings have been removed. Carrying out a coronavirus risk assessment will continue to be a legal requirement for businesses, employers and event organisers, and they must take **reasonable measures** to minimise the risk of exposure to coronavirus.

We have conducted a risk assessment to identify appropriate reasonable measures at alert level zero to protect staff and guests

Wearing of face masks is no longer a legal requirement and is at the discretion of guests and staff as to whether they are worn.

Although 2m social distancing is no longer mandatory we will maintain ample spacing in our dining areas as well as good ventilation. Full table service will continue to be provided in dining areas.

For guests staying more than one night rooms will be refreshed daily. If you do not want housekeepers to enter your room during your stay please notify reception on arrival.

We will continue to maintain thorough cleaning regimes in all areas of the building. Hand sanitisers will remain in place in public areas for use by guests.

If you have tested positive for coronavirus please do not travel. There is no cancellation charge for bookings made directly through our website or
